At the House of Hope:

- 85% of families come here from domestic violence backgrounds
- 95% of families achieve at least 2 goals in the areas of education, employment, and housing
- 95% of families graduate into stable housing and enroll in Aftercare



Aftercare Program

Most families are with House of Hope between six to twelve months before entering long-term housing. Upon graduation from the program, families remain connected to a caring network of support for several years through our Aftercare Program.


